Double Fees for Late Entry

In order to give slalom organisers a chance to know how many were entering their slalom - so that course length could be made to measure, programmes printed etc. - The BCU Slalom Committee ruled [see BCUSC Sheet headed " Divisional Changes ".] that:-

... entries should be received by the organisers not later than the Monday preceeding the Slalom. Late entries will only be accepted on payment of double entry fee.
